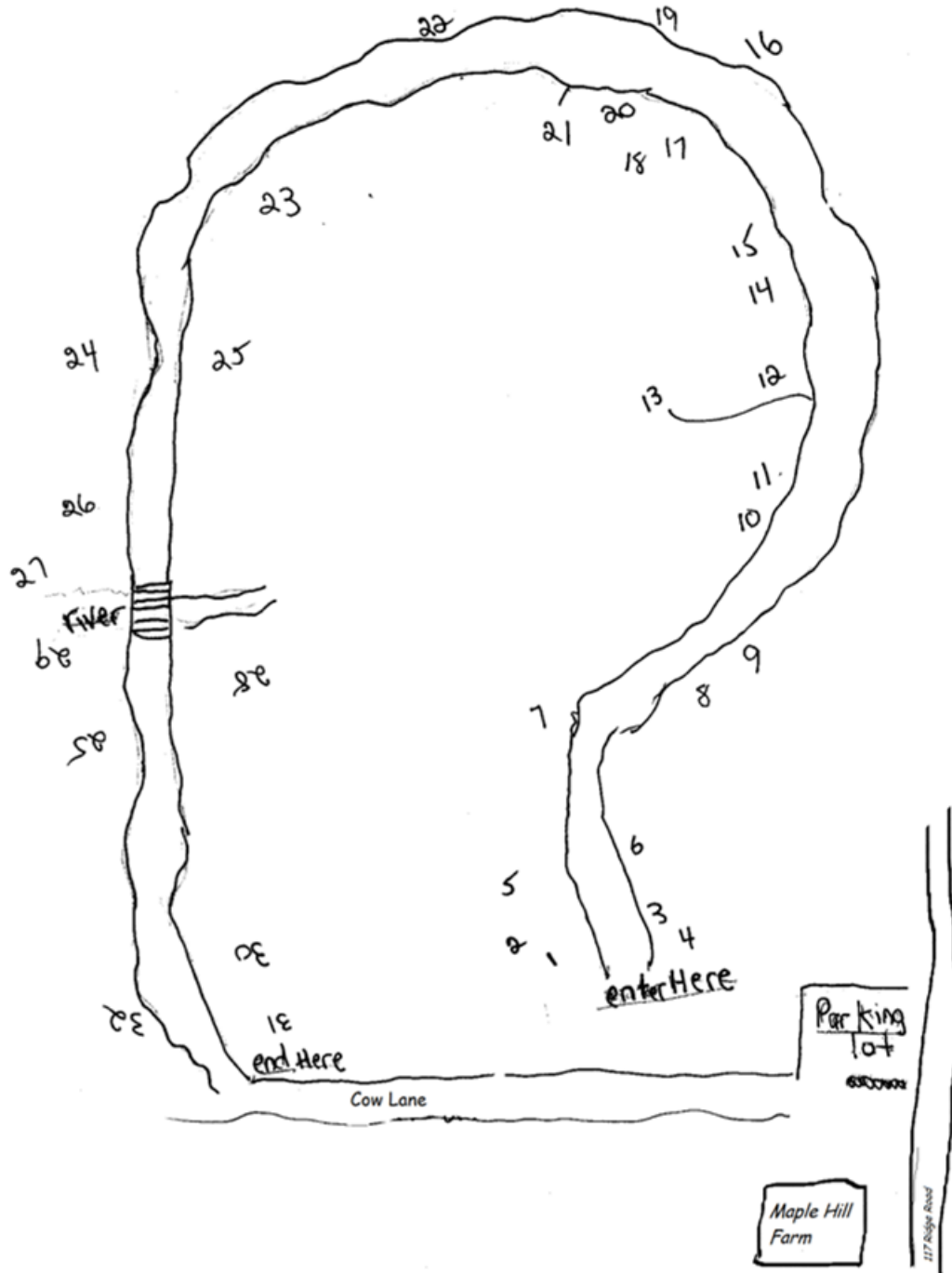


Enjoy Looking for These Catepillars and Butterflies Along the Wildflower Trail of Beaver Brook!

1. **Queen Anne's Lace** Look for Annise Swallowtail and Black Swallowtail catepillars
2. **Golden Rod** Look for American Painted Lady, American Snout, Clouded Sulphur Red Admiral
3. **New England Aster** Look For American Painted Lady, American Snout, Orange Sulphur, Cabbage White, Red Admiral
4. **Little White Aster** Look for American Painted Lady, Baltimore Checkerspot
5. **Bush Honeysuckle** Look for White Admiral
6. **Bee Balm**
7. **Wild Rose** Look for checkerspots and Morning Cloak Catepillars
8. **White Wood Aster** Look for American Painted Lady, Blackswallowtail
9. **Solomon's Seal**
