Focus on Natural Settings

ELIGIBILITY

Original artwork by both amateurs and professionals is eligible. Recent artwork is preferred. This is a NON-JURIED event, but Beaver Brook Association retains the right to reject any work that does not meet the criteria.

MEDIA

Color or black and white photography; prints and paintings (watercolors, oils, acrylics, pastels, collage and mixed media); indoor and outdoor sculpture in various media. **Please do not submit needlework or craft items.**



ARTWORK CRITERIA

FOCUS: The accent of the artwork should be on New England natural settings but art reflecting a nature theme elsewhere in North America may be included.

- Artwork criteria will allow some man-made items as long as they are NOT THE PRIMARY SUBJECT of the work; such as barns, covered/stone bridges, paths, dirt roads, wood fences, stone walls, flowers, trees, gazebos, arbors, boats, etc. Please - no people subjects in artwork.
- Domesticated animals may be included if shown as part of the landscape, but cannot be the only subject of the artwork.

PRESENTATION

1. Please understand the barn is subject to drastic temperature and humidity changes; prepare your artwork accordingly.
2. We will only be able to accept artwork with lightweight frames. Unframed artwork will not be accepted for hanging.
3. All work must be ready for secure hanging. See hanging instructions.
4. **SIZE:** Limit is 24x30 inches, outside dimensions.
5. Freestanding sculpture must be accompanied by an appropriate mounting stand.
6. **ATTACH** a Title form to the back of each piece of artwork submitted.

SALES & COMMISSIONS

Art sold during the festival may not be picked up by the buyer until Sunday, September 29 after 5 PM. **There is a 25% commission to Beaver Brook Association on any sales during the Festival.** The proceeds benefit Beaver Brook's mission of environmental education and land stewardship.

ENTRIES & FEES

Three (3) entries max per artist.
\$15.00 Entry Fee per artist.

PICK UP OF ARTWORK

Artwork should be signed out and picked up between 5 & 6 PM on September 29. If artwork cannot be picked up that day, it should be picked up within two weeks during regular office hours Monday-Friday 9-3 PM.
